SPECIAL JOINT BOARD MEETING WITH ELDORA-NEW PROVIDENCE  
February 26, 2018

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, February 26, 2018 in the South Hardin Middle School Science Room with board members present: Brandy Eilbeck, Jacob Bolson, Leon Schwartz, Bob Westendorf and Keith England presiding. Eldora-New Providence board members present: Jared Cook, Nick LaVelle, Greg Salvo, Nancy Callaway and President Maggie VanderWilt presiding. Jolene Teske & Jay Stanish were absent. Others present were: Superintendents Patricia Heinz and Jay Mathis; Principals Joe Taylor and Mike Rundall; Board Secretaries Debra England and Cindy Bierle; staff Kelly Matteson and media—Corey Meints.

Keith England called the special meeting to order at 6:30PM for H-R. Maggie VanderWilt called the special meeting to order for E-NP. Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the agenda. MC The E-NP board also approved the agenda.

Joe Taylor and Mike Rundall talked about what the Middle School and High School buildings had been doing for teacher collaboration and transitioning students. The various departments from the Middle School met with their counterparts at the High School on Feb. 19<sup>th</sup> to talk about scope and sequences of classes. They also discussed behaviors for success. Both Principals discussed what their buildings were doing for professional development this year.

The youth sports program was discussed. The Greater Eldora Youth Sports Program has changed its name to the South Hardin Youth Sports Program. There are advantages of having kids involved in the sports program prior to 6<sup>th</sup> grade and already knowing each other prior to going to school together. Both boards had a discussion about having Middle School sports practice on Wednesdays. The consensus was for a couple of board members from each board to meet and decide on common colors and logos for school promotion.

Mr. Mathis and Mrs. Heinz reviewed the spring proration and compared them to the fall numbers.

The boards discussed the proposed two options for the school calendar. One option has a Spring Break and second one does not. After discussion, both boards seem to be leaning towards having a spring break, but both will vote on their calendar selection at their March board meetings.
