MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

October 15, 2018

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, October 15, 2018 in the Library at the Radcliffe School. Board members present Jacob Bolson, Brandy Eilbeck-arrived at 6:32pm, Keith England, Leon Schwartz and Bob Westendorf presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Middle School Principal Joe Taylor; Elementary Principal Brian Mangold; Board Secretary Debra England; staff – Lauren Johnson, Courtney Friest; former student Kylee Zoske and media—Corey Meints.

Bob Westendorf called the regular meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Bolson to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Schwartz to approve the minutes from the September 24, 2018 regular board meeting. MC Motion by Bolson, seconded by England to approve the reports on budget and warrants. MC

Kylee Zoske presented about a possible service learning project and fundraiser with a Dance Marathon. This is a local version of the Dance Marathon that the University of Iowa School does for the Children's Hospital.

Ms. Johnson and Mrs. Friest shared info on the new things happening at South Hardin Middle School: PBIS, STREAK, Community Connections and The Clothing Closet.

Mr. Mangold reported the elementary students participated in the Healthiest State Walk on October 3rd. He hosted a Coffee With the Principal Day to allow families to meet with him and discuss the beginning of the school year. Both Radcliffe and Hubbard Fire Departments came to the school on Oct. 10th for Fire Prevention Week.

Mr. Taylor reported the Middle School is trying new nights and a different format for their parent teacher conferences. The fall sports season is wrapping up and play practice has started. This year's play Did Someone Say Murder? will be performed at 7PM on both Friday, November 16th and Saturday, November 17th. The Middle School will host their annual Veterans' Day Program on November 9th at 10AM.

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the sharing agreement with AGWSR for the shared Teacher Librarian for the 2018-19 School year. MC

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Eilbeck to approve the District Delivered Service Delivery Plan as presented. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Eilbeck to approve the directional signage bid with Nagel Sign Company. MC

Dr. Zellmer presented the board survey results. After discussion motion by England, seconded by Schwartz to have the buildings and grounds committee look at the Radcliffe Bus Barn, Hubbard Solar and Radcliffe Solar projects and develop a one to three-year plan on plans to move forward with these projects and potential financing options. MC

The board discussed some potential items for next week's joint board meeting agenda next week.

Motion by England, seconded by Bolson to approve the sale of healthy snacks at the middle school for PBIS and the Junior Dance Marathon for the University of Iowa Children's Hospital. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Schwartz to approve the contract change for KD Burkett. MC

Dr. Zellmer shared the proposed 2019 IASB Legislative Priorities. October is National Principal Month and he recognized Mr. Mangold and Mr. Taylor. The door wraps have been installed at Hubbard and Radcliffe and they look great.
