

HUBBARD-RADCLIFFE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

May 20, 2019

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, May 20, 2019 in the Hubbard Board Room. Board members present Jacob Bolson, Leon Schwartz and Bob Westendorf presiding. Brandy Eilbeck and Keith England were absent. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Middle School Principal Joe Taylor; Elementary Principal Brian Mangold; Board Secretary Debra England; coaches – Paul Miller and Craig Halfpop and school attorney— Rick Engel.

Bob Westendorf called the regular meeting to order at 6:35PM.

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Bolson to approve the minutes from the April 15, 2019 regular board meeting and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

There was no community input.

Dr. Zellmer presented certificates to all the school board members in recognition of School Board month and thanked them for their service.

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to advertise and hire a new Junior High Basketball Coach for 2019-20. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the 2019-20 Non-union Contracts with a 2% salary increase from 2018-19 contracted salaries as presented. MC

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Bolson to approve the transfer of funds from the All Athletic account to the MS Uniforms account which are subaccounts within the Activity Fund. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the agreement with School Administrators of Iowa (SAI) to provide mentoring for the 2019-20 school year for Middle School Principal Sarah Nachazel. MC

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Bolson to approve the Sharing Agreements with Eldora-New Providence for ELL, Food Services Director, Transportation Director, and Webmaster for 2019-20. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the bid from Creasion Store for the replacement countertops in the Elementary Gym Bathrooms and in the Family Consumer Science Room in the amount of \$6,360.00. MC

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Bolson to approve the bid from Z&Z Glass for replacement of the door on the Radcliffe Elementary gym in the amount of \$2,500. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the removal of the old baseball and softball crows nest by Hayden Boeke and Levi Anderson. MC

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Bolson to accept the resignation of teacher Robin Bishop at the end of the 2018-19 school year and coaches Nick Eller and Jennifer Sheldahl. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve contracts for teachers Jeanette Reyes and Benjamin French for the 2019-20 School Year pending background checks and for 2019-20 PLC Coach Mentor: Paige Moberly. MC

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Bolson to approve the contract change for Nick Eller from FTE .75 to FTE 1.0 for 2019-20 and the transfer of Kiley Groninga (Schipper) to 5th grade for 2019-20. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA) request for Rebecca Caldwell. MC

Mr. Mangold reported getting input from all teachers for the 2019-2020 Professional Development. All ISASP testing is completed and finishing FAST assessments. The HR Elementary visited Eldora for an Old Creamery Theatre Performance with ENP. On May 22nd all 5th grade students will visit the Middle School. May 23rd is the Showcase Day and an FFA AG Awareness morning.

Mr. Taylor reported baseball and softball practice has started. June 5th the middle school will have a pool party. Last week they had the grand opening of the TIGERMART. KCCI covered this event.

A high school report was sent.

Dr. Zellmer shared a legislative update that the SAVE extension has passed but is still waiting to be signed by the governor. Youth Mental Health First Aid Requirement is a small amendment added to the Youth Mental Health Bill, but it has big implications for schools and PD training. He summarized the summer projects for both the Hubbard and Radcliffe buildings.
