

HUBBARD-RADCLIFFE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
REGULAR & JOINT BOARD MEETING WITH ELDORA-NEW PROVIDENCE

October 21, 2019

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, October 21, 2019 in the South Hardin High School Media Center with board members present: Jacob Bolson, Brandy Eilbeck, Keith England, Leon Schwartz and Bob Westendorf presiding. Eldora-New Providence board members present: Nancy Callaway, Jared Cook, Greg Salvo, Nick LaVelle, Jay Stanish and President Maggie VanderWilt presiding. Jolene Teske was absent. Others present were: Superintendent Dr. Zellmer; Principals Brian Mangold, Sarah Nachazel, Mike Rundall and Kevin Henrichs; Board Secretaries Debra England and Cindy Bierle; staff Greg Pfantz and media—Corey Meints.

Bob Westendorf called the H-R board to order at 6:30PM. Motion by Bolson, seconded Eilbeck to approve the agenda. MC Maggie VanderWilt called the special meeting to order for E-NP. The E-NP board approved the agenda.

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the minutes from the September 16, 2019 regular board meeting and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

There was no community input.

Kathy Enslin a candidate for the Central Rivers AEA Board addressed the boards. Martin Reimer from the Iowa Valley Community College shared a presentation on the upcoming College Bond Issue. The boards shared many positives they have seen so far in the 2019-20 School Year. Mr. Rundall presented on Career & Technical Education, Future Ready Iowa & AIW (Authentic Intellectual Work) programs at the high school. Mr. Pfantz presented on the upcoming FFA trip to the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis.

Mr. Henrichs reported on what was happening at the ENP Elementary building.

Mr. Mangold reported on all the activities happening at the HR elementary. On Oct. 11th a free book was given to all of the elementary students. The At Home Reading Program was kicked off to promote literacy.

Mrs. Nachazel reported middle school fall sports wrapped up last week. Rehearsals will be starting for the fall play, "Hoodie". The fall play will be held on November 15. The first middle school dance will be on October 24th.

Mr. Rundall reported on what was happening at the South Hardin High School building.

Dr. Zellmer reported on the enrollment numbers for both districts. He also highlighted some of the activities and opportunities happening in the district for both staff and students.

Motion by England, seconded by Schwartz to approve employment contracts for Diane Kulow for Food Service and Mike Olson for Junior High Wrestling Coach pending background checks if needed. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Eilbeck to approve the contract change for Alysha Heue. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the SBRC application for modified allowable growth for Open Enrollment Out in the amount of \$123,268.80 and ELL Instruction beyond 5 years for \$1,536.04. MC

Motion by Schwartz, seconded by Eilbeck to approve the fall 2019 Whole Grade Sharing Proration as presented. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Eilbeck to approve Quakerdale Promise Academy Students to participate in all Middle School extra-curricular activities. MC

Dr. Zellmer asked board members to let the school know if they planned to attend the pre-conference on November 20 or the conference on November 21st so registrations can be finalized for the 2019 IASB Convention.

Dr. Zellmer asked both boards to give advice, tips and tricks for the new school board members after elections to continue the work of working together jointly to best impart #OurKids and #OurSchools.
