The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, November 18, 2019 in the Radcliffe School Library. Bob Westendorf called the regular meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Motion by Eilbeck, seconded by England to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Schwartz to approve the minutes from the October 21, 2019 regular and joint board meeting and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

There was no community input.

Alyssa Stille and Macy Roskens, two talented and gifted students, presented their plans for another Book Drive Project. The two plan to have hot chocolate with the donations to be given to the Blank Children's Hospital in Des Moines.

Julie Schroeder talked about the Promise Academy and how the new program worked. She asked for partial or full waiver for their junior high students to participate in the South Hardin Junior High Athletics.

Motion by Eilbeck, seconded by Schwartz to approve charging a fee of \$50 per sport per child, not to exceed the maximum of \$200. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Schwartz to approve Kellie Drury as a Volunteer Junior High Girls Basketball Coach pending a background check. MC

Motion by Eilbeck, seconded by England to approve a contract for teacher Brynn Brass. MC
