MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

January 20, 2020

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, January 20, 2020 in the Radcliffe School Library. Board members present Jacob Bolson – arrived at 6:32pm, Keith England, Ashley Halvorsen, Nathan Weig and Bob Westendorf presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Elementary Principal Brian Mangold; Middle School Principal Sarah Nachazel; Board Secretary Debra England and media—Corey Meints.

Bob Westendorf called the regular meeting to order at 6:29PM. Motion by England, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Weig to approve the minutes from the December 16, 2019 regular board meeting and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

No community input was received.

Dr. Zellmer shared with the board a report of the 5yr Financial Health of the school district.

Mr. Mangold reported having a science assembly right after Christmas break. The assembly focused on our watershed and water quality. The Elementary now has a traveling trophy to improve behavior around a specific focus of our PBIS expectations. The Times Citizen came to interview one student from each grade. We look forward to seeing them in the paper and hearing them on the radio.

Mrs. Nachazel reported MAP testing has started in Math and ELA to allow teachers to monitor student's progress. The wrestlers and the boys' and girls' basketball teams are fun to watch. Mr. Hoelscher was planning to take 9 students to the Karl King Honor Band in Fort Dodge. Unfortunately, the event was cancelled due to the weather. Auditions for the Spring Musical started today.

Mr. Rundall sent a high school report.

Dr. Zellmer shared that the all district staff training on January 10th went well and received lots of positive feedback. Plans are beginning for budgeting and staffing for the next year. Work continues on the Strategic Improvement Plan.

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Weig to approve the At-Risk/Dropout Prevention Funds for the 2020-21 School Year be used for Counselor Salaries, Academic & Behavioral Intervention Instruction, Success Center Coordinator and School Social Worker. Motion carried on a roll call vote. Ayes: Bolson, England, Halvorsen, Weig, Westendorf Nays: None.

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve the request to the School Budget Review Committee (SBRC) for Modified Supplemental Amount and Supplemental Aid for the 2020-2021 At-Risk and Dropout Prevention Program in the amount of \$146,482.00 for the expenditures necessary to implement the 2020-2021 At-Risk and Dropout Prevention Program plans as approved by the Hubbard-Radcliffe CSD school board. Motion by Weig, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the first reading of Early Retirement Policy 407.6, 407.6E1 and 407.6E2. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Bolson to accept the FY2019 Audit Report. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Weig to approve the two Open Enrollment Applications to the Eldora-New Providence CSD and to deny the Open Enrollment request of one student to CAM. MC
