SPECIAL BOARD MEETING

April 13, 2020

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, April 13, 2020 electronically via Zoom. The meeting originated from the Eldora-New Providence District Office Board Room. Board members present Jacob Bolson, Keith England – via phone, Ashley Halvorsen, Nathan Weig and Bob Westendorf presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Board Secretary Debra England; two patrons and media—Corey Meints.

Dr. Zellmer ran the meeting to aide easier communication. Dr. Zellmer called the special meeting to order at 5:30PM. Motion by Weig, seconded by England to approve the agenda. MC

No community input was received.

Motion by England, seconded by Halvorsen to accept the resignation of teacher Sarah Backstrom-Baker effective at the end of the 2019-20 School Year. MC

Motion by Weig, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the ratification of the 2020-21 Contract with the HREA with a 2% total package increase. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the issuance of contracts for all employees for the 2020-21 School Year. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve the 2020-21 School Calendar as amended for Homecoming and the release of the football schedule. MC

Motion by England, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the Emergency Resolution regarding the continuity of essential operations for the Hubbard-Radcliffe School District in response to COVID-19 including provision to pay all employees throughout all of the days of required closure. This resolution also added that the district will use a Voluntary Continuous Learning Model during the closure. MC
