

HUBBARD-RADCLIFFE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

April 20, 2020

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, April 20, electronically via Zoom. The meeting originated from the Hubbard-Radcliffe District Office. Board members present Jacob Bolson, Ashley Halvorsen, and Bob Westendorf presiding. Absent were Keith England and Nathan Weig. Others present were: Superintendent Dr. Adam Zellmer; Elementary Principal Brian Mangold; Middle School Principal Sarah Nachazel; Board Secretary Debra England; staff—Linda Halfpop and media—Corey Meints.

Dr. Zellmer ran the meeting to aide easier communication. Dr. Zellmer called the regular meeting to order at 6:30PM. Motion by Bolson, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve the minutes from the March 13, 2020 special negotiation meeting, the March 23, 2020 regular board meeting, the March 25, 2020 special negotiation meeting, the April 13, 2020 special board meeting and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

No community input was received.

Mr. Mangold reported Distance Learning started last week. Teachers are sending specific lessons/activities 5 days a week and are asked to make themselves available for virtual office hours. The teachers are meeting via Zoom to support each other with remote learning and to finish work on Writing Standards.

Mrs. Nachazel reported the first week of distance learning started April 13th. Teachers have been setting up Zoom meetings with students to provide learning opportunities. They are using the same model as the high school. The Middle School teachers are also holding virtual office hours. Paras are invited to participate in the online learning with teachers and students.

Mr. Rundall sent a high school report.

Dr. Zellmer gave a shout out to staff and families for staying calm and everyone jumping in to work together.

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve a contract for teacher Kristy Kiley for the 2020-21 School Year pending a background check. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve the AEA Purchasing Agreement for 2020-21. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve the Audit Engagement Agreement with Anderson, Larkin & Co for 2019-20. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the first reading of Board Policy 508.2. MC

Mr. Mangold presented some options for going to a four-day preschool versus a five-day preschool model for the 20-21 School Year. The plan would still provide options for wrap-around care for students five days per week.

The next regular board meeting will be Monday, May 18, 2020 at 6:30PM in the Library at the Hubbard-Radcliffe Elementary. It will be determined closer to that date if it needs to be another electronic meeting.
