SPECIAL JOINT BOARD MEETING WITH ELDORA-NEW PROVIDENCE

August 4, 2020

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, August 4, 2020 in the South Hardin High School Auditorium with board members present: Jacob Bolson—via Zoom, Ashley Halvorsen, Nathan Weig and Bob Westendorf presiding. Absent: Keith England Eldora-New Providence board members present: Marc Anderson, Emily Herring, Nick LaVelle, Greg Salvo, Jay Stanish and President Maggie VanderWilt presiding. Jared Cook was absent. Others present were: Superintendent Dr. Zellmer; Principals Brian Mangold, Sarah Nachazel, Mike Rundall and Kevin Henrichs; Board Secretary Debra England; staff, some patrons and media. The rest of the public could participate in the meeting via Facebook Live.

Dr. Zellmer presented the draft of the Return to Learn & Reopening Plan.

Maggie VanderWilt called the special meeting to order for E-NP. The E-NP board approved the agenda.

Bob Westendorf called the H-R board to order at 6:23PM. Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Weig to approve the agenda. MC

There was a public comment session where 4 people spoke in person and 9 emails were submitted for public comment to be shared with the board. The public comment time was closed at 6:56PM

Dr. Zellmer responded to some of the comments made during public comment time. The board discussed the Return to Learn & Reopening Plan. The E-NP board approved the plan with some clarification to the wording. Motion by Bolson, seconded by Weig to approve the Return to Learn & Reopening Plan for the 2020-2021 school year with a change in wording to the plan to make face coverings, shields, and desk shields a requirement whenever social distancing can't take place. Periodic breaks from wearing a mask and shield will be consistently developed within each building's local context to provide consistency and make the policy enforceable.
