MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

November 16, 2020

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, November 16, 2020 in the Hubbard Success Room. Board members present Jacob Bolson, Keith England – via Zoom, Ashley Halvorsen – via Zoom, Nathan Weig – via Zoom and Bob Westendorf presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Elementary Principal Brian Mangold; Middle School Principal Sarah Nachazel – via Zoom; Board Secretary Debra England; and media—Corey Meints.

Dr. Zellmer ran the meeting to aide easier communication. Dr. Zellmer called the regular meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Weig to approve the minutes from the October 20, 2020 regular and joint board meeting and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

There was no community input.

Dr. Zellmer presented our updated financial information and our situation has improved significantly from two years ago.

Mr. Mangold reported celebrating Red Ribbon Week Oct. 26-30. The elementary had a Halloween Costume Parade around the park in Radcliffe. The elementary enjoyed having the High School Volleyball team come for an assembly prior to going to state. Virtual Parent Teacher Conferences seemed to go very well for both teachers and parents.

Mrs. Nachazel reported basketball practice started last week. Wrestling and cheerleading started today but all Junior High sports will be put on hold due to the Governor's announcement tonight concerning COVID. The middle school teachers had great participation for their virtual parent teacher conferences. The PBIS Team planned activities in connection with Red Ribbon Week for the middle school.

A high school report was sent.

Dr. Zellmer reported finishing up the final set of fall state reporting. He reminded board members that he would be attending the virtual IASB Convention and invited board members to join him for the convention.

Motion by Bolson, seconded by England to approve the SBRC application for modified allowable growth for Open Enrollment Out students not included in the district's previous year's certified enrollment count in the amount of \$81,872.00. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve the SBRC application for modified allowable growth for ELL Instruction beyond 5 years for \$3,141.60. MC

Motion by Weig, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the two Open Enrollment Out Applications. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve the Special Education Contracts with Roland-Story CSD and Eldora-New Providence. MC

Dr. Zellmer shared updated COVID-19 numbers and current department of health guidance. Dr. Zellmer expressed his desire to keep kids in school in person as long as we can do it safely for both students and staff.

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Halvorsen to approve contracts for associates Lacey Vazquez and Jason Van Haaften pending background checks. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Weig to approve the FMLA Leave Request for Kiley Schipper. MC
