The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, February 15, 2021 in the Library at the Radcliffe School. Board members present Jacob Bolson – via Zoom, Keith England– via Zoom, Ashley Halvorsen, Nathan Weig– via Zoom and Bob Westendorf presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Elementary School Principal Brian Mangold – via Zoom; Middle School Principal Sarah Nachazel – via Zoom; Board Secretary Debra England.

Dr. Zellmer ran the meeting to aide easier communication. Dr. Zellmer called the regular meeting to order at 6:30PM. Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Weig to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Weig to approve the Special Education Contracts with Iowa Falls CSD and South Hamilton CSD. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Westendorf to approve setting the 2021-22 Budget Hearing for 6:30PM on Monday, March 22, 2021 at the South Hardin Middle School Success Center. MC

Dr. Zellmer shared the Covid-19 numbers for the district.
