The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, May 17, 2021 in the South Hardin Middle School New Gym with board members present: Jacob Bolson, Keith England, Ashley Halvorsen, Nathan Weig and Bob Westendorf-via phone. Eldora-New Providence board members present: Jared Cook, Greg Salvo, Jay Stanish-arrived at 6:33PM and President Maggie VanderWilt presiding. Marc Anderson, Emily Herring, Nick LaVelle attended on-line. Dr. Zellmer ran the meeting to facilitate the virtual meeting. Dr. Zellmer called the H-R board to order at 6:30PM. Motion by Bolson, seconded Halvorsen to approve the agenda. MC Maggie VanderWilt called the special meeting to order for E-NP. The E-NP board approved the agenda.

Breanne Butler, Michael Rundall, Jennifer Rundall, Heather Bonin, and Janelle Guiles gave public input on the mask requirement and the Return to Learn Plan.

Dr. Zellmer explained his recommendation based on the changed guidance provided by the Iowa Department of Public Health. After discussion by the board, motion by Bolson, seconded by Weig to make masks optional for all students, staff, parents and community members effective at 12:00AM on Tuesday, May 18, 2021. Motion carried on a roll call vote Ayes: Bolson, England, Halvorsen, Weig, Westendorf Nays: None A similar motion was passed by the E-NP board to repeal the mask mandate for the remainder of the school year and make masks optional.
