

HUBBARD-RADCLIFFE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

May 17, 2021

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, May 17, 2021 in Hubbard New Gym. Board members present Jacob Bolson, Ashley Halvorsen, Nathan Weig and Keith England presiding. Bob Westendorf was absent. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Elementary School Principal Brian Mangold; Middle School Principal Sarah Nachazel; Board Secretary Debra England; patrons, media—Corey Meints.

Keith England called the regular meeting to order at 7:05PM. Motion by Bolson, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the minutes from the April 19, 2021 regular board meeting, and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

Lance Below asked a question about the current year calendar during community input.

Dr. Zellmer presented the school board with recognition certificates for their service to the school district.

Mr. Mangold reported the elementary classes have been taking field trips or have a trip scheduled. The elementary has been doing lots of end of the year assessments, working on plans for Summer School, and plans for the 2021-2022 school year.

Mrs. Nachazel reported baseball, softball and driver's education started this week. The middle school is working on summer school plans to try to meet the needs of all the students and also meeting with Eldora students in Eldora. This week the 8th grade students will visit the high school on Wednesday.

Mr. Rundall sent a high school report.

Dr. Zellmer addressed the parent question stating that since students missed a quarter of their instruction last year, we are trying to provide all of the instructional hours possible this year. He shared he is planning for the Middle School Principal interviews on Tuesday and will continue political advocacy as the state legislature continues to work.

Dr. Zellmer explained that no bread bids were received and that we are exploring our options for bread. Motion by Weig, seconded by Bolson to approve the Milk Bid with AE Dairy for \$19,230.50 for the 2021-22 school year. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Weig to approve the bid for the FY2022-24 Audits with Anderson, Larkin, & Co. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Weig to approve the Sharing Agreements with Eldora-New Providence for the 2021-22 School Year: Social Services Counselor, Food Services Director, Transportation Director, Athletic Director, ELL Teacher, and Webmaster. MC

Motion by Weig, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the open enrollment out applications for 3 students and the one open enrollment in. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the purchase of 53 chromebooks from SHI at a cost of \$14,839.47 using the REAP grant funds. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Bolson to approve the updated 2021-22 school calendar. MC

Motion by Weig, seconded by Bolson to approve the transfer of \$5,600 from All Athletics to the Concessions Activity Fund which are both subaccounts within the Activity Fund to cover the negative balance. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Weig to approve the Elementary Fundraising request with Kona Ice to raise money for PBIS activities. MC

Motion by Weig, seconded by Halvorsen to accept the resignation of teacher Jeanette Reyes, coach David Shindelar at the end of the 2021 baseball season, and the immediate resignation of associate Rachel Smith. MC

Motion by Bolson, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the employment contract for teachers Amanda Puffet and Robin Olmstead, bus driver Dale Hinderaker and para educator Lisa Clifford pending licensure and background checks. MC

The survey is all complete and they are now working on the bid packages the Radcliffe Bus Barn Project. The plan is to start advertising that we will be taking bids for the project and have the bids back and be able to approve bids at our regular June board meeting.

The board discussed section 2 of the book study Schools Cannot Do It Alone.
