MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

January 17, 2022

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, January 17, 2022 in the Library at the Radcliffe School. Board members present Laura Imsland, Ashley Halvorsen, Tracey Rieks, Bob Westendorf-via phone and Jacob Bolson presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Elementary School Principal Brian Mangold; Middle School Principal Dan Spooner; Director of Teaching, Learning & Assessment Report Sherri Walker; Board Secretary Debra England and media—Corey Meints.

Jacob Bolson called the regular meeting to order at 7:00PM. Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Rieks to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by Imsland, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the minutes from the December 20, 2021 regular meeting and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

There was no community input.

Dr. Zellmer reviewed the Iowa School Leadership Standard 1: Mission, Vision & Values.

Dr. Zellmer reported what he has been working on and reminded the board that work on the next budget would be happening soon.

Motion by Imsland, seconded by Halvorsen to purchase a Hotsy Power Washer for the Bus Barn for \$7,799.20. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Halverson to approve the ESSER 3 Plan. MC

Motion by Westendorf, seconded by Halverson to approve the Open Enrollment out requests for the 2022-2023 school year. MC

Dr. Zellmer shared some topics that would typically be covered at the Joint Board Meeting in February. Bolson made a couple of suggestions. If other ideas came up, they were to be shared with Dr. Zellmer or the board president.

Dr. Zellmer updated the board on the status of the bus barn project in Radcliffe. Doors are on and the building is all buttoned up. They are finishing electrical, plumbing and the office area and hope to be completely done soon.
