

HUBBARD-RADCLIFFE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

November 21, 2022

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, November 21, 2022 in the Library at the Radcliffe School. Board members present: Ashley Halvorsen, Laura Imsland, Tracey Rieks, Bob Westendorf – via phone and Jacob Bolson presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Elementary School Principal Brian Mangold; Middle School Principal Dan Spooner; Board Secretary Debra England, and media— Corey Meints.

Jacob Bolson called the regular meeting to order at 7:00PM. Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Rieks to approve the agenda. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Westendorf to approve the minutes from the October 10, 2022 regular meeting minutes and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

No community input was received.

Mr. Mangold reported having a Scholastic Book Fair November 14-18. They added \$2,000 worth of new books to the Elementary Library this year. Parent-Teacher Conferences went well and had very good attendance. On Friday, Nov. 18th, all elementary students took home a free book as part of the Books For Kids program.

Mr. Spooner reported Girls' Basketball is rolling along well. Boys' Basketball will start after the semester break in Jan. Wrestling will have their first home meet on Dec. 1st. Student Leadership held a food drive the last week of October. The Middle School held a Veteran's Day program on Nov. 11th which was well attended.

Mr. Rundall sent a high school report.

Sherri Walker sent an updated report on teaching, learning and assessments.

Dr. Zellmer reported attending the Hardin County Economic Engineering Summit. The 3-day event focused on a countywide effort to grow the county.

Dr. Zellmer reviewed the 2022 District Financial Health Report with the board. The financials have improved a lot from 4 years ago.

Motion by Imsland, seconded by Rieks to accept the resignations of Para: Carrie Miller. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Rieks to approve contracts for Heather Bonin Para and Joey DeHart JH Boys Basketball Coach, pending licensure and background checks. MC

Motion by Imsland, seconded by Rieks to approve the Special Education Contract with Eldora-New Providence CSD. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Imsland to approve the sharing agreement for an instrumental music teacher with Eldora-New Providence Community School. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the ESSER 3 Plan. MC

Motion by Imsland, seconded by Rieks to approve the 3 Middle School PBIS Fundraiser Requests. They will be selling items to raise funds for PBIS celebrations, student incentives, and items for the Tiger Store. MC

Motion by Westendorf, seconded by Halvorsen to approve the contract with Cottingham and Butler for ACA Reporting Services. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Rieks to approve the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for modified supplemental amount for Open Enrollment Out students who were not included in the district's previous year's certified enrollment count in the amount of \$152,489.70. MC

Motion by Imsland, seconded by Westendorf to approve the district's administration to submit a request for \$1,947.40 to the School Budget Review Committee for modified supplemental amount related to the English Language Learning program for students who have exceeded 5 years of weighted funding in the Fall of 2022. MC

Motion by Halvorsen, seconded by Rieks to approve the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for modified supplemental amount for Increased Enrollment not included in the district's previous year's certified enrollment count in the amount of \$20,223.00. MC

The School Improvement Committee will meet jointly with E-NP and HR to discuss items like school lunches/pictures. Imsland and Halvorsen are on the School Improvement Committee. The Building & Grounds committee consisting of Bolson and Rieks will also meet in January to walk through buildings and discuss priorities.

Bolson and Dr. Zellmer shared their takeaways from the Iowa Association of School Boards (IASB) Convention the past week.

The next regular board meeting will be Monday, December 19, 2022 at 7:00PM in the Success Room at the Hubbard School.
