REGULAR & JOINT BOARD MEETING WITH ELDORA-NEW PROVIDENCE

October 17, 2023

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Tuesday, October 17, 2023 in the Success Room at the South Hardin Middle School in Hubbard with board members present: Tracey Rieks, Bob Westendorf-via phone and Jacob Bolson presiding. Absent – Ashley Halvorsen, Laura Imsland. Eldora-New Providence board members present: Marc Anderson, Breanne Butler, Emily Herring, Nick LaVelle, Jay Stanish, Maggie VanderWilt and President Jared Cook presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Dr. Zellmer; Principals Brian Mangold, Mike Rundall, Kevin Henrichs, Kassandra Albright; Sherri Walker; Board Secretaries Debra England and Cindy Bierle; students, staff and media.

Jacob Bolson called H-R Board to order for the regular and joint meeting with E-NP at 6:31PM. Motion by Rieks, seconded by Westendorf to approve the agenda. MC Jared Cook called meeting to order for E-NP. The E-NP board approved the consent agenda.

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Westendorf to approve the consent agenda, minutes from the September 18, 2023 regular board meeting and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

There was no community input.

Senator Sweeney and Representative Meggers joined the board for a discussion on the legislative issues impacting our rural schools.

Mr. Henrichs reported working hard on some specific goals for the MS. The focus of Professional Development is working on ways to support all students. There are plans to do a daily 20-minute time period for intervention/extension work once all of the planning is in place.

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Westendorf and carried unanimously to appoint Laura Imsland to be the IASB delegate for the Delegate Assembly at the 2023 IASB Annual Convention.

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Westendorf to approve the first reading of Bullying and Harassment policies 104 and 104-R(1). MC
