

HUBBARD-RADCLIFFE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
MONTHLY BOARD MEETING

November 18, 2024

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, November 18, 2024 in the Library at the Radcliffe School. Board members present: Marty Eide, Laura Imsland, Kelli Miller, Tracey Rieks, and Jacob Bolson presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Adam Zellmer; Elementary School Principal Brian Mangold; Middle School Principal Kevin Henrichs; Director of Teaching, Learning & Assessment Report Sherri Walker; Board Secretary Debra England; staff—Ellen Mesch, Brynn Brass, Carole Spiehs, Kathy Murphy, and media—Corey Meints.

Jacob Bolson called the regular meeting to order at 6:30PM. Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the agenda. MC

No public comments were heard or received for the Public Hearing for the flexibility account transfer.

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the minutes from the October 14, 2024 regular meeting, October 21, 2024 special board meeting, and the reports on budget and warrants. MC

No community input was received.

Trent Grundmeyer and Shannon Bisgard gave the board an update on the Superintendent search process.

The Admin Team presented on the 2024 Iowa School Performance Profile released this past week.

Mr. Mangold reported the elementary Grades 3-5 were invited to attend the Veteran's Day Assembly at the middle school. The 2nd graders received free "Just Like Caitlin" books donated from the Jensen Family.

Mr. Henrichs reported the middle school is looking at new ELA curriculum to review. The band and choir preformed well at the Veteran's Day Program on November 11th. On December 9 the 6-12 Band & Choir Extravaganza will be held at the high school.

Mr. Rundall sent a high school report.

Sherri Walker reported having a K-12 meeting for all of the Special Education Teachers.

Dr. Zellmer reported it would be possible to have a shared School Resource Officer between Hubbard-Radcliffe and Eldora-New Providence Schools. It would just call for all of the affected parties to sign off on the sharing.

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the correction to the October 14th board minutes and approve the total cost of \$62,076.38 for the SHMS Auditorium Audiovisual Upgrades with DB Acoustics. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Eide to approve the resolution to transfer \$57,230.38 from the HSAP Fund to the Flexibility Funds for the Middle School sound system in the auditorium. Motion carried on a roll call vote. Ayes: Bolson, Eide, Imsland, Miller, Rieks Nays: None Absent: None

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Miller to approve the review of the 300 Series of School Board Policy. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the Iowa School Safety Grant purchases from Riverside Technologies, Inc (RTI) for \$39,259.05 for the HR Elementary and \$44,068.44 at South Hardin Middle School to update the school camera systems. MC

Motion by Eide, seconded by Rieks to approve the contract with Cottingham and Butler for ACA Reporting Services for 2024. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Miller to approve the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for modified supplemental amount for Open Enrollment Out students who were not included in the district's previous year's certified enrollment count in the amount of \$117,075.00. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the district's administration to submit a request for \$2,054 to the School Budget Review Committee for the modified supplemental amount related to the English Learner program for students who have exceeded 5 years of weighted funding in the Fall of 2024. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Eide to approve the employment contract for Ryan Dalton JH Basketball Coach pending background check where required. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Miller to approve the FMLA Leave Request for Jenny Raska. MC

Dr. Zellmer updated the board on the status of the Solar Project. Alliant Energy will be connecting the elementary solar array over the Thanksgiving break. The plan is for the middle school project to be done in ten days but the wet and windy days are slowing that progress.

Our enrollment count is down 3 students but our enrollment trend projection is pretty steady for the next 5 years.

The next regular board meeting will be Monday, December 16, 2024 at 6:30PM in the Success Room at the Hubbard School.
