The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Tuesday, June 10, 2025 in the Success Room at the Hubbard School with board members present: Marty Eide, Laura Imsland, Kelli Miller, Tracey Rieks and Jacob Bolson presiding.
