October 13, 2025

The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, October 13, 2025 in the Success Room at the South Hardin Middle School in Hubbard with board members present: Marty Eide, Laura Imsland, Kelli Miller and Jacob Bolson presiding. Jacob Bolson called H-R Board to order for the work session with Eldora-New Providence at 6:07PM. Motion by Miller, seconded by Eide to approve the agenda for the work session. MC Jared Cook called meeting to order for E-NP. The E-NP board approved the agenda.

Tammi Drawbaugh and Katherine Solan from the Iowa Association of School Boards conducted a Board Development Workshop to assist board members with their roles and responsibilities.
