The Board of Education of the Hubbard-Radcliffe Community School District met Monday, August 17, 2026 in the Library at the Radcliffe School. Board members present: Marty Eide, Laura Imsland, Erin Nelson, Tracey Rieks and Jacob Bolson and presiding. Others present were: Superintendent Chris Fenster; Elementary Principal Cari Teske; Middle School Principal Crystal Reinertson; Director of Teaching, Learning & Assessment Report Sherri Walker; Board Secretary Debra England, and Media Casey Jarmes.

Jacob Bolson called the regular meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Eide to approve the agenda. MC Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the minutes from the July 20, 2026 regular board meeting with the addition of adding the first reading of 507.2E2 to the minutes and the monthly financial reports on budget and warrants and the following consent agenda items: resignation for Cindy DeMott as a para. Contracts for volleyball coach Jamie Geisler, transfer of Austin Meyers to Grounds/Custodial position and transfer of Shelly Warnecke to a custodian. MC

Motion by Imsland, seconded by Eide to set Mental Health, School Safety, Sharing & Reorganization Funding and Student Achievement as our top Priorities for the Iowa School Board Association Legislative Priorities for 2026-27. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Eide to approve the \$.03 fuel discounts from both Innovative Ag Services and Radcliffe Farmers Coop Elevator for the 2026-2027 school year. Motion carried with Imsland abstaining.

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the financial depositories as follows for the 2026-27 school year: Seven million five hundred thousand dollars for the Iowa Schools Joint Investment Trust (ISJIT), Hardin County Savings Bank in Eldora and Security State Bank-Hubbard/Radcliffe. Nelnet for \$60,000 as the vendor for all JMC transactions. The official bank depository for the district's checking account is Hardin County Savings Bank. The school district will also maintain certificates of deposit and HIFI/Savings accounts at Hardin County Savings Bank-Eldora, and Security State Bank-Hubbard/Radcliffe. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Nelson to approve the sharing agreement for school librarian with Webster City Community School District. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the lane change request of Jenniffer Konomi to move from BA24 to MA. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Nelson to approve the 2026-27 School Fee and Lunch Fee Schedule as presented. MC

Motion by Rieks, seconded by Imsland to approve the 2026-27 Elementary and Middle School Handbook updates. MC
